GENERAL INFORMATION / RULES & REGULATIONS

LOCATION: The market is situated at the Suisun Waterfront on the Harbor Center Street Side of the waterfront. Take the Suisun Waterfront exit from Highway 12.

HOURS OF OPERATION: Saturdays from 9am-1pm. 2023 Season: July 1 – Oct 28, 2023.

SET-UP: Vendors can start setting up at 7:30am. Vehicles are not allowed on the market premises. Parking is available next to the market. **STAKES OR WEIGHTS ARE REQUIRED.**

BREAK DOWN & CLEAN UP: The market will close promptly at 1pm. Vendors are strictly prohibited from breaking down early. Full participation for the entire market hours is required. All areas must be clean when departing.

WEEKLY FEES: Vendor fees will be collected at the beginning of each market day for Non-Chamber Members. Credit cards on file will be processed the day prior to the market, unless a notification of non-attendance is provided at least 2 days before the market.

CANCELLATIONS: If you are unable to attend the market, please call (707) 425-4625 or email info@fairfieldsuisunchamber.com by 12pm on Thursday afternoon. Failure to cancel will result in being responsible for paying for the space.

INCLEMENT WEATHER: In case of unfavorable weather conditions, please call the Market Manager by noon on Friday at (707) 425-4625 or email info@fairfieldsuisunchamber.com.

GROWERS: Prices must be clearly displayed, and a Load List must be provided at the end of each market. Vendor space should be left in a clean and sanitary condition. If samples are offered, please provide a trash container. Required identifying banners include Farm/Ranch, location, and "We Grow What We Sell" signage.

FOOD VENDORS: The menu with prices must be clearly marked. Only items listed on your vendor application can be sold. Item limitations may be in place to avoid overlapping of similar items.

ARTS & CRAFTS: Handmade items are preferred and will receive first consideration. Producers may reject vendors with overlapping craft items.

NON-PROFITS: Booths must be supervised by an adult at all times. Flying or roaming throughout the market is not permitted. Distributing consumables (food/drink items) is not allowed. Large groups can contact the Fairfield-Suisun Chamber of Commerce to coordinate space.

ALL VENDORS: Canopies are mandatory. Early breakdowns are not permitted & WEIGHT ARE REQUIRED.

Equipment and displays must remain inside your canopy, and your area must be kept clean at all times. Market spaces are assigned by the Market Manager. Smoking or alcohol consumption is not allowed during market participation. Only Food Vendors can provide food. Your business name or organization must be displayed at all times.

I am applying for a vendor space at the Suisun City Waterfront Farmers Market. I have read and agreed to the above Rules & Regulations. I will also communicate all of these conditions to my staff/volunteers. I understand that I must cancel by 12pm on the Friday prior to the market day, or I will be charged the regular booth fee.
